Background

Life-long public servant who has collectively spent over three decades in the military and as a county judge

After graduating from the United States Military Academy at West Point, Self began his military service in the 82nd Airborne Division of the US Army

Served at the tactical, operational, and strategic levels of the US military and held = positions including infantry platoon leader, special forces detachment commander, and company commander

Spent a significant portion of his military service overseas, including deployments to Grenada and Bosnia; served in Joint Staff assignments at the US European Command and the NATO Military Headquarters in Belgium

Recalled to active duty after 9/11 and was deployed to Afghanistan and the Persian Gulf from 2002-2003

Elected in 2006 as a county judge in Collin County, which is a largely executive role in Texas; focused on tax and pension reform issues and served three consecutive terms before retiring in 2018
