Ran after-school programs for disadvantaged kids while attending law school and has remained involved in the community through his non-profit work at organizations including the Cancer Foundation for Life, Discovery Science Place, and the Whitehouse I.S.D. Education Foundation. Involved in numerous local and national Republican organizations such as the Smith County Republican Club, the Smith County Republican Party, and the Republican Party of Texas

Represented District 5 as a city council member for the Tyler City Council from 2005 to 2009; was re-elected in May 2009 but resigned shortly after in order to take a job closer to a special school with a program that would benefit his deaf son

Assumed his current position as county judge in 2016, a primarily executive role in Texas
